The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 72 dated 26.04.2017 registered under Sections 336, 506 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, on the basis of compromise dated 28.04.2017 (Annexure P-2).
