The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case First Information Report No.0674 dated 08.12.2017 under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Shivaji Colony, Rohtak.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been compromised with the complainant.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned counsel for the complainant.

In view of the fact that the matter has been amicably

settled between the parties, the petitioner is directed to join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him on bail on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that the petitioner will fully cooperate with the Investigation Officer, failing which order may be recalled.

Petitions stands disposed off.
