Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.328 dated 06.12.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Section 307 IPC (added later on) and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

On 07.05.2018, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has since been discharged from the hospital but he is to be readmitted there shortly in connection with his surgery and he has been advised with bed rest.

Learned State counsel submits that though the investigating officer had contacted the petitioner while he was admitted in the hospital but petitioner did not render full cooperation and did not get the recovery effected. However, considering the fact of the case it has been agreed that the investigating officer would go to the

residential house of the petitioner and put a questionnaire to him recording his answers and copy of the questionnaire with answers be placed on file and if it comes out that petitioner is not rendering full cooperation then appropriate inference would be drawn against him. Learned State counsel further submits that the counter version set up by the petitioner was enquired into but was found to be false.

To come up on 20.7.2018.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Krishan Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation, a sword has been recovered from him and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
