AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

This revision petition is directed against the judgment and order dated 08.09.2016 passed by the Judicial Magistrate, Ist class, Jalandhar, vide which the petitioner was convicted and sentenced under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act for a period of one year and cheque amount of Rs. 1,68,000/- was ordered to be paid as compensation along with 9% interest thereon. In an appeal preferred by the petitioner, the same was dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar on 30.05.2017.

The petitioner has been able to pay the total cheque amount of Rs. 1,68,000/-.

Keeping in view the fact that the complainant-respondent No. 2 has received the cheque amount, the present revision petition is partly

allowed by upholding the conviction order but reducing the sentence of the petitioner to the period already undergone.
