Learned counsel for the State, as also learned counsel for the complainant, submit that the sale of scrap of the company by the petitioner and his accomplices goes to the tune of Rs.62 lacs over a period of years, with learned counsel for the complainant further submitting that as a matter of fact in a CD recorded by the complainant, the petitioner has also admitted his guilt and also his sworn affidavit to that effect.

Without making any comment on the admissibility of the aforesaid CD/affidavit as evidence in any manner, or even on the merits of the case otherwise, looking at the nature of allegations against the petitioner, I see no reason to entertain this petition, which is consequently dismissed.
