AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court praying for protection of the life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Mr. Harchand Singh Batth has appeared and filed his vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5, namely, Surjeet Singh son of Raghbir Singh and Kulwinder Kaur wife of Surjeet Singh, who are parents of petitioner No.1. The same is taken on record.

At the request made by counsel for these two respondents, parties were given opportunity to interact with each other. After the interaction, counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 state that they have no objection to the relationship of the petitioners. He further states that neither there is any threat or any intent on the part of respondents No.4 and 5 to harass the petitioners in any manner. These respondents No.4 and 5, who are present in Court further state that they have already facilitated for further studies of petitioner No.1 in Canada and all formalities have been completed except of receipt of visa, as the fee has also been deposited and visa is expected any time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for respondents No.4 and 5, on instructions from these respondents present in Court, there appears to be no reason why the petitioners should have any apprehension of threat at the hands of these respondents. However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have submitted a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar dated 21.02.2018 (Annexure P-4), the said authority, i.e. respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, District Amritsar as well as SHO Police Station Vijay Nagar, District Amritsar-respondent No.3 may look into the same and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.

The petition stands disposed of.
