On 08.05.2018, the following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioner on the basis of the legal notice (Annexure P3) and the complaint has submitted that the address of the petitioner has been given by mentioning a wrong post office address as the post office of the village of the petitioner is Kartarpur whereas it is wrongly mentioned as Mehtapur and, therefore, the petitioner has neither received the legal notice nor the proclamation was made at the ordinary place of residence of the petitioner and thus, he could not face the proceedings. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and face the proceedings, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion for 24.08.2018.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on or before 21.05.2018 and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds and on payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- on account of delaying the proceedings to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Kapurthala.

The payment of costs shall be a pre-condition before accepting the bail/surety bonds of the petitioner.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has already appeared before the Trial Court on 21.05.2018 and has been released on bail and has deposited the costs of Rs.10,000/-.

Respondent No.2 has appeared in person and has filed the reply stating therein that the petitioner is involved in two other FIRs.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that he is on bail and is facing trial.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
