[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

[3]. At this stage, Mr. Sandeep Godara, Advocate, puts in appearance and files his power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant.

[4]. In this petition, the petitioner prays for being released on bail in case FIR No.49, dated 08.04.2006, under Section 324/34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur. He was originally on bail but absented from proceedings on account of which coercive processes were issued against him and he was ultimately declared a Proclaimed Offender in the year 2008.

[5]. In the meantime, a compromise was arrived at between the parties and the co-accused in the case had already been acquitted. The

petitioner now apprehends his arrest in view of the proclamation order pending against him even though the offence involved in the case (under Section 324/34 IPC) was bailable.

[6]. In the given circumstances, the present petition is disposed off with a direction that the coercive processes issued against the petitioner shall remain stayed for one week during which period he shall surrender before the Ld. Trial Court and seeks fresh bail.

[7]. This order shall automatically stand vacated after one week.
