The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.232, dated 24.09.2016, under Section 21/25/29/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected in the present case is 2 kgs and 500 grams of heroin.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Azad Singh apprises the Court that the petitioner is a habitual offender and is involved in four other case under the NDPS Act.

In view of the above and keeping in view the heavy recovery effected from the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner benefit of bail.

Petition is dismissed.
