The petitioner has preferred the instant petition against the order dated 07.01.2017, passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Panipat, vide which the application for extension of time for furnishing probation/surety bond has been dismissed.

Heard. Vide judgment dated 28.09.2016, passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Panipat, petitioner was ordered to be released on probation on furnishing requisite probation bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/successor Court, to keep peace and maintain good behaviour for a period of one year. However, he was also directed to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/-, as compensation to the complainant party i.e. Rs.7,000/- to injured Parmod and Rs.3,000/- to injured Vinod.

Due to some reasons, petitioner could not submit the probation bonds, therefore, he was taken into custody on 22.12.2016 and till date he is in custody. The petitioner has deposited an amount of Rs.10,000/- as compensation, as awarded by the learned Appellate Court.

Keeping in view these circumstances, the petitioner be released on probation as per order of the learned Appellate Court, subject to furnishing requisite bonds. However, amount of Rs.10,000/-, deposited by the petitioner, be paid to injured Promod and Vinod, as ordered by the learned Appellate Court.

Disposed of accordingly.
