The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.129, dated 04.12.2017, under Sections 324/307/506/148/149/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar (Nawanshahr).

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Ashok Kumar in relation to an alleged occurrence dated 03.12.2017.

Allegations are that during the late evening hours, the complainant was assaulted by the occupants of two vehicles i.e. one black colour scorpio vehicle being driven by the present petitioner and a swift car driven by Ram Kumar. Malkhan @ Makhan is stated to be armed with a knife and having inflicted knife/kirch blows on the complainant in the abdominal and chest area.

The precise role attributed to the present petitioner is of having twisted left arm of the complainant and thereby having facilitated co-accused Malkhan @ Makhan in having inflicted the knife blows.

Injuries suffered by the complainant have attracted offence under Section 307 IPC.

In view of the serious allegations and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Petition is dismissed.
