Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.120 dated 04.08.2017, registered under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar, District Amritsar Rural.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Briefly noticed, FIR came to be registered on the statement of Ramesh Kumar, Finance Head of M/s BLSE Solutions Private Limited. Allegations are that the present petitioner who was employed by the firm as a runner had collected over a period of time certain sums of money

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from three Sewa Kenders being run by the firm, but correspondingly had deposited lesser amount.

Precise allegations are that the petitioner has misappropriated the amount of Rs.9.61 lacs approximately and has even forged and made interpolations in the pay-in-slips.

Petitioner was arrested on 08.08.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan has been furnished.

Trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Offences are triable by the Magistrate.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Disposed of.
