This petition has been filed challenging order dated 11.05.2017, whereby the learned trial Court has declined to summon respondents no.2 and 3 as additional accused to face trial in FIR No. 45 dated 07.05.2016, under Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

FIR No. 45 dated 07.05.2016, was registered on the statement of the petitioner against three persons i.e. respondents no.2, 3 as well as Shri Pal @ Shri Ram. The Investigating Agency found respondents no.2 and 3 to be innocent during investigation and Shri Pal @ Shri Ram was proceeded against.

Learned counsel for the State on the last date of hearing had brought to the notice of this Court that the co-accused-Shri Pal @ Shri Ram has been acquitted by the learned trial Court on 02.11.2017. As there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the said date, the matter was adjourned in the interest of justice.

Today, again there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is no longer interested in pursuing this matter.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
