2. Loan to the tune of Rs.14,50,000/- was apparently taken on the strength of forged documents.
3. The petitioner's contention in this regard is that he is innocent but all the forgeries were done by the Bank officials.
4. *Per se* the submission is unconvincing and irrational since undisputedly the loan amount went into the petitioner's own account.
5. Custodial interrogation to determine culpability of the

actual persons involved in creation of the forged documents would appear to be called for.

6. No ground in the circumstances exists to grant the extraordinary relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The interim bail granted in favour of the petitioner earlier on 28th February, 2018 accordingly stands cancelled.

7. Dismissed.
