This revision petition is against the order dated 24.4.2017 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar dismissing the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 5.4.2017 passed by Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Jagadhri whereby the application for grant of bail to the petitioner has been dismissed.

Report of the learned trial court which transpires that the prosecution has cited 29 witnesses, out of which, 19 has already been examined and 6 has been given up.

However, it is specifically added in the report of learned trial Court that the prosecution intends to move an application under Section 311 Code of Criminal Procedure for calling the concerned doctor again.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and gone through the material available on record.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the petitioner is in custody for the last one year and the fact that disposal of the appeal before the trial court shall take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the concerned learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board.
