the representation of the petitioner within a period of three months, on

receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representations dated 24.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) and dated 08.04.2016 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
