The petitioner has filed the present petition for quashing of order dated 05.02.2011 passed by JMIC, Ludhiana in case FIR No.163 dated 03.08.2010 registered at Police Station, Sahnewal, District Ludhiana, under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 474 IPC (Section 120-B IPC added later on). Vide the impugned order the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender.

While issuing notice, this Court had directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail.

Thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such. The trial Court shall confirm the interim bail granted to the petitioner subject to its satisfaction.
