Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondent No.3 for taking appropriate action on the subject matter of the petition wherein petitioner has alleged that he was married to respondent No.4 on 27.01.2008 and a male child was born to them. The child is in custody of respondent No.4. Petitioner is settled in Dubai wherein he is working as JCB Driver.

Petitioner has also alleged, payment of huge money to respondent No.4, who is having alleged illicit relations with respondent No.5.

In the aforesaid context, collusion of respondents No.3 to 5 has been alleged to harass the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing any reply, as no order prejudicial to the interest of either party is being passed.

At this stage, without taking into consideration the allegations of the petitioner, respondent No.2 can be asked to look into the grievance of the petitioner and to pass appropriate order on the representation dated 22.01.2018 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner in accordance with law.
