The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 145 dated 10.10.2017 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drug and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 08.03.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation on 24.03.2018 and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.
