The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.20 dated 02.02.2018, registered under Sections 452, 325, 308, 506 and 34 of IPC, at Police Station Payal, Khanna, Ludhiana.

Heard both sides.

Perused the available material. More than one fracture has been detected on the head of the victim. Even though the weapon of offence allegedly happens to be blunt in nature but the manner of assault and the type of injuries caused to the victim would indicate a more sinister intention.

In the given circumstances, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
