The present petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code (for short 'Cr.P.C.') is for directing the respondents No.1 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.5 who is trying and making an attempt to forcibly take away the vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No. (PB05L9910) with the help of recovery agents.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Amandeep Kaur, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Attari, Amritsar Rural, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4, stating therein that the vehicle of the petitioner has not been taken in possession by the financing Bank- respondent No.5. The statement of the parties have also been recorded by the police. The Bank/respondent No.5 has stated before the police that the Bank would take the proceedings of Arbitration against the petitioner and do not intend to forcibly take away the vehicle in question.

In view of the above, no further orders are required in this case.
