In the present petition, petitioners seek anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.26 dated 21.02.2018 under Sections 186, 353, 341, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1).

2. This Court vide order dated 01.03.2018 had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Shashvat Kumar states that in pursuance to the order dated 01.03.2018 petitioners have joined investigation. Petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of these factual aspect and circumstances, without

expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 01.03.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, are hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners will abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, the petitioners will not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and they will also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
