AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Pursuant to the order dated 01.03.2018, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hoshiar Singh, submits that the petitioner has appeared before the learned Area Magistrate and deposited a sum of ₹12,70,000/- as was the consideration shown in the sale deed, Annexure P-2.

That being so and the property in question already being subject matter of dispute in civil proceedings, I see no reason why the interim order dated 01.03.2018 should not be made absolute.

Ordered accordingly.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Area Magistrate to have the aforesaid amount ₹12,70,000/- deposited in a fixed deposit in the local branch of the State Bank of India in the name of the petitioner, with directions to the bank to not allow the amount to be withdrawn even on maturity, till the decision of the civil Court, so that the

amount would carry interest and eventually be payable to the person who is declared to be the rightful claimant thereof, alongwith the interest which would have accrued upon it.
