GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 289 dated 16.10.2014 under Sections 420/467/468/471 IPC registered at Police Station, Cantonment, District Amritsar City and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties qua the present petitioners.

Vide order dated 11.01.2018 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for getting their statements recorded with regard to compromise, so as to ascertain genuineness of the compromise.

Report of JMIC, Amritsar, District Sangrur has been received, wherein it has been stated that pursuant to the order dated 11.01.2018 statements of complainant Kuldeep Kumar and of accused Harpal Singh, Ankush Mahajan and Mamta Rani have been recorded. The learned trial Court in its report has opined that the compromise arrived at between the parties appears to be genuine and had been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion and with free will of the parties.

In view of the aforesaid position, this Court is satisfied that the matter has been resolved amicably. As such, the petition is hereby accepted and the FIR and all subsequent proceedings are ordered to be quashed.
