Prayer in this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case4 F.I.R. No.417 dated 02.10.2017 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Jodhewal, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is innocent and the matter relates to some family dispute. Moreso, the applicant-appellant is of the tender age and has been falsely implicated in this case.

Learned State counsel contended that the petitioner had given three sword blows to Vipin Kumar with an intention to kill him and even the weapon used for commission of offence is yet to be recovered and the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above fact that the petitioner gave sword blows to Vipin Kumar and the weapon of offence is yet to be recovered, no case for enlargement of the petitioner on anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
