Short reply on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 by way of affidavit of Sh. Amit Bhatti, Sr. Executive Engineer, PSTCL, P&M Division, Wadala Granthian, District Gurdaspur has been filed which is taken on record.

Application disposed of.

Main case

In compliance of the order dated 06.03.2018, costs of Rs.5000/- has been paid by the official as imposed by the Court for not filing the reply within the stipulated time.

In compliance of the order dated 25.10.2018, affidavit of Amrik Ram, Sr. Executive Engineer, PSTCL, P&M Division, Wadala Granthian, District Gurdaspur has been filed which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that in the affidavit, it has been deposed that the case of the petitioner was under process. A sum of Rs.7,63,633/- was payable and after deduction of TDS, net amount of Rs.5,16,021/- has been paid to the petitioner towards arrears of pay. He further states that pay of the petitioner has also been revised. In this view of the matter, nothing survives in the writ petition and the same ought to be disposed of as infructuous.

In view of the above, present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, petitioner is granted liberty to represent the respondents Corporation in the event of the submissions made in the affidavit are not to his satisfaction.
