The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.548 dated 30.06.2017, registered under Sections 148,149,323,379-B of the Indian Penal Code, Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 201,325,34 IPC added lateron, at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

The petitioner was arrested on 29.11.2017 more than 5 months ago. In the meantime, investigation has already been completed and challan submitted against the petitioner. Co-accused Yash Pal was granted bail by the Id. Court below also. The petitioner stands on a similar footing, from the FIR as well as the material available in the case diary on the basis of which challan has already been submitted.

In the circumstances, further detention of the petitioner is not justified.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, concerned.
