The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case F.I.R. No.195, dated 26.09.2017, under Sections 307/324/326/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that co-accused, Vijay Kumar and Paras and against whom there were similar allegations have been granted benefit of regular bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 02.02.2018 in CRM-M-3609-2018.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 30.09.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan has been presented.

Trial is stated to be at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

In view of the above and on the ground of parity itself,

petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petition disposed of.
