The petitioner has not been specifically named in the FIR, though he is stated to be one of 6 to 7 other persons accompanying one Tejinder Singh @ Press, who collectively are stated to have been beaten up the complainant with sharp-edged weapons and base ball bats. An identically placed co-accused, Malkiat Singh @ Meeta, who was also not named in the FIR, is admitted to have been enlarged bail on 20.04.2017.

Without making any comment whatsoever on the involvement or non-involvement of the petitioner in the occurrence, which shall be gone into by the investigating agency and the trial court at the appropriate stages, on the basis of parity alone, it is directed that the petitioner, upon joining investigation, if he is sought to be arrested, would be released on bail, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Illaq Magistrate, subject to his complying with all conditions

stipulated under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
