The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioners for issuance of a direction to official respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 7 to 16. In this regard the petitioners have also approached the authorities by filing representation dated 19.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) but till date no action has been taken by respondent No.2 on the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.2 be directed to look into the representation dated 19.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take action in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Sandhu, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 6. Three copies of the petition be handed over to him by learned counsel for

the petitioners during the course of the day failing which no action is called for. He submits that representation dated 19.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) will be decided within a period of four weeks.

Heard.

Without going into the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation dated 19.02.2018 (Annexure P-5), within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order and take necessary action in accordance with law.
