For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and copy of MLR of petitioner No.2 is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Learned counsel contends that respondents No.6 to 15 gave severe beating to the petitioners on their objecting to the encroachment of the public street as well as on their not being allowed to use the said street by said respondents. The petitioners claim to have made representation dated 07.06.2017 (Annexure P/7) to respondent No.5 as also representation dated 20.07.2017 (Annexure P-8) to respondent Nos.2 to 5, for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.6 to 15.

Grievance of the petitioners is that despite lapse of sufficient period of time, no action has been taken by the official respondents on the same

and the private respondents are threatening the petitioners to compromise the matter else face dire consequences.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of by directing the official respondents to consider and decide the representations dated 07.06.2017 and 20.07.2017 (Annexures P/7 and P/8) and take action in respect thereto in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 5 only. Mr. Kuldeep Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to the learned State counsel in the Court.

On perusal thereof, learned State counsel submits that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioners.

Accordingly, in view of the statements of learned counsel for the parties, the petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to conduct an inquiry on the representation dated 20.07.2017 (Annexure P/8) himself or through concerned SHO and take action in respect thereto, if any warranted in the circumstances of the case, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within 2 months from date of order.

Petition stands disposed of in aforementioned terms.
