Saroj Bala etc. filed in COMA No. 45499 of 2012 dated 07.08.2012 titled as Saroj Bala and another Vs. Kanwar Raj Singh for the offences punishable under Sections 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and 420 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No. 7, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.
