Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in an appeal the order of the trial Court was confirmed but the petitioners were directed to be released on probation on depositing compensation and requisite bonds within fifteen days. It is submitted that a copy of the order dated 07.02.2018 was received on 23.02.2018 and, therefore, the petitioners were unable to comply with the conditions imposed by the learned Sessions Judge within the prescribed period.

The petition is disposed of with the clarification that although the order states that requisite bonds and compensation is to be deposited within 15 days from the date of order, the same is not possible unless a certified copy of the order is made available to the party. Since the certified copy of the order was made available only on 23.02.2018, the petitioners would be well within his right to comply with the conditions dated 07.02.2018 within fifteen days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

With the above observations, the present petition is disposed of.
