In the present petition, petitioner seek anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.26 dated 21.02.2018 under Sections 186, 353, 341, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. This Court vide order dated 01.03.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Shashvat Kumar states that in pursuance to the order dated 01.03.2018 petitioner has joined investigation. Petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of these factual aspect and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 01.03.2018,

granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.

6. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
