Vide order dated 08.03.2018, following order was
passed:-

“Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner(s) in case FIR No. 67 dated 26.01.2018, registered under Section(s) 147, 149, 452 & 506 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that in respect of alleged occurrence dated 16.01.2018, FIR came to be registered only on 26.01.2018. No allegation has been made in the FIR that the petitioner was carrying any gun or caused injuries to the complainant or any other person. No description of vehicle has been given in the FIR so as to enlarge the scope of false implication at a later

stage. Learned counsel further contended that mode of arrival in the house of the master of the complainant is also missing. Learned counsel further contended that petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent. A copy of paper-book be provided to learned counsel for the respondent(s) during the course of the day.

List on 16.03.2018.

Meanwhile, petitioner(s) are directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioner(s) shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. The petitioner(s) will join the investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 08.03.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation.

This fact has been admitted by learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Punam Chand.

In view of above, order dated 08.03.2018 is made absolute.
