This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.175 dated 09.08.2011 registered under Sections 354, 363, 366, 376, 511, 506 IPC at Police Station City, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a bare perusal of the FIR would show that no rape is committed on the young prosecutrix. Appearance has been put in on behalf of the prosecutrix and an affidavit has been filed on her behalf as Annexure P-2 stating that she would have no objection in case FIR is quashed.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State submitted that petitioner has been in custody since 15.02.2018 after having been surrendered in Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner surrendered in Court and prosecutrix has given an affidavit to the effect that she has no objection to the quashing of FIR, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the

satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, any opinion expressed herein is for the purpose of grant of regulation bail and not an opinion on the merits of the case.
