RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

1. Earlier, petitioner was on bail. On 04.08.2017, he did not appear before the trial Court and his bail was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State.
2. The absence was stated to be on account of wrong recording of date as 06.08.2017.
3. During the intervening period, the Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana issued non-bailable warrants against the petitioner in addition to notice under Section 446 Cr.P.C. issued to the surety.
4. Owing to the conduct of the petitioner, no indulgence under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure can be granted. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

5. However, petitioner would be at liberty to surrender before the trial Court. In the event of doing so, his prayer for regular bail shall be decided within a week.
