The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.4 dated 09.01.2014 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 356, 379 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Kotwali, Bathinda.

Heard.

It is a case of prosecution that a mobile phone was snatched by two unknown desperadoes.

Learned State counsel informs that recovery of mobile phone has been effected from co-accused Balkaran Singh.

In this view of the matter, the petition is allowed subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.

(iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
