2.) Petitioner has sought for the following relief:-

“Petition under section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure with a prayer for issuing order of direction to respondent no. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the present petitioner and his family from respondents 4 and 5.

And to fairly and independtly further investigate the matter on the representations made many times by the petitioner to official respondent no.2 against respondents 4 and 5. Keeping in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case as per law.”

3.) Learned counsel for the State filed status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Akashdeep Singh Aulakh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of

Police, Sub Division, Dhuri on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 dated 16.05.2018.

4.) Learned State counsel submitted that matter relates to some matrimonial dispute among the petitioner, wife of the petitioner and relatives, namely respondent Nos.4 and 5. During pendency of the present petition, parties have settled their issues amicably on 12.03.2018. Thereafter, once again petitioner raised a complaint. Even to that official respondents have responded and held an inquiry in terms of inquiry report dated 15.3.2018 and 19.03.2018, Annexures R-2/T and R-3/T, respectively. In view of these facts and circumstances, grievance of the petitioner do not survive for consideration.

5.) Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
