The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.223 dated 18.9.2017, registered at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana, under Sections 420, 120-B, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Malkit Singh submits that the petitioner has still not joined investigation. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner has failed to abide by his commitment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner accepts the statement made by counsel for the complainant. He, however, prays for another period of 15 days to make the payments.

The petitioner has violated the commitment given by him on two occasions. Thus, there is no reason to grant him any further extension of time.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
