The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.51 dated 08.08.2017, registered under Sections 324, 326, 323, 379-B, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

It has been contended that the petitioner alongwith his associates gave a 'dattar' blow on the right hand of the complainant and the said injury is simple in nature and that the co-accused has also been granted bail.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 06.03.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
