Petitioner has assailed the order dated 22.11.2017 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Kapurthala vide which order dated 28.07.2017 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phagwara was set aside and directions were issued to Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phagwara to give one opportunity to the complainant to deposit the proclamation charges.

Earlier, the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phagwara vide order dated 28.07.2017 dismissed the complaint under Section 204(4) Cr.P.C. for want of deposit of proclamation charges.

Since, review was not maintainable against the said order, therefore, revisional Court granted indulgence and

directed for providing one opportunity to the complainant to deposit the proclamation charges.

Having done so, in my considered opinion, no error of jurisdiction has been committed by the revisional Court.

Petitioner in any case has to appear only after proper service of summons. No prejudice is going to be caused to the petitioner by way of granting opportunity to the complainant for depositing proclamation charges.

This petition is found to be devoid of merits and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
