The petitioners are seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

On 01.03.2018, the order was passed qua ensuring that no harm or threat is caused to the lives and liberty of the petitioners. The case was adjourned for today.

Today, neither the counsel for the petitioners has come present nor the petitioners themselves present in the Court.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioners have not approached the Court with clean hands because the address given in the petition has never been the residence of the petitioners. Their whereabouts are not known to the police. Otherwise they are residents of UP.

In view of the above, it appears that petitioners are no more requiring any further order from the Court.
