AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail in the light of registration of FIR No.6 dated 10.01.2018, at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka, under Section 61 of the Excise Act, against him.

Perusal of the FIR would show that recovery of 20 liters of *lahan* and 3 bottles of illicit liquor has been effected and the petitioner, at the time when the raid was being carried out, fled away from the spot.

Notice in this case was issued.

Counsel for the State has informed the Court that apart from the present case, there are 5 other cases against the petitioner under the Excise Act and two cases under the Gambling Act, out of which, he has already been convicted in two cases.

Keeping in view the above, prayer made by the petitioner in the present application cannot be accepted. The petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
