The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.22 dated 26.1.2018 under Sections 27 and 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Daresi, Ludhiana.

As per case of the prosecution, pursuant to an information received by the police to the effect that Ashok Kumar and his son Gaurav sell 'heroin' and liquor outside their house, a raid was conducted outside their house. It is alleged that while Gaurav alongwith 7-8 other persons fled away, the police was able to nab one person namely Ashok Kumar, father of the petitioner, and from whose possession 1.5 grams of 'heroin' was recovered.

Notice of this petition was issued to the State.

The learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has since joined investigation and is no longer required for the purpose of any further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid position, wherein I find that the petitioner was not arrested at the spot and has already joined investigation and is not stated to be required for any further investigation, the petition is hereby accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 7.3.2018 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
