This is a petition has been filed seeking cancellation of bail that has been granted to respondents No.2 to 5 in FIR No.25 dated 06.02.2018, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, under Sections 452, 354-B, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that after the anticipatory bail had been allowed, accused-respondents No.2 to 5 came to the house of the petitioner and threatened her and this was reported to the Station House Officer Chamkaur Sahib.

Notice of motion has been issued in the matter.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh, submits that no such application is found on the record and Annexure P-3 is a concocted application.

On the other hand, learned counsel appearing on behalf of accused-respondents No.2 to 5 submit that all allegations as set out in the instant petition seeking cancellation of bail are false. In fact, the mother of respondent No.2 has been assaulted by two sons of the petitioner herein, in which regard a DDR has been recorded.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that there is a categoric averment made by the counsel for the respondent-State that no such incident took place and the fact that there is no record of Annexure P-3 on the case file, the instant petition stands disposed of. However, while disposing of this petition, it is left open to the petitioner to seek cancellation of bail in case, there is violation of any of the terms of bail granted to the private respondents.
