This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0014, dated 28.01.2018 under Sections 379/411 IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 06.03.2018.

“Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIRNo.0014, dated 28.01.2018, under Sections 379/411 IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural.

Counsel would submit that FIR has been registered on the basis of secret information. Co-accused, Sarabjit Singh and Pardeep Singh were arrested and recovery of the stolen motorcycles was effected from them. Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, he was neither apprehended on the spot nor has any recovery been effected from him. Further categoric contention made by counsel is that the petitioner is not involved in any other FIR involving similar allegations.

Notice of motion, returnable for 17.04.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear

before Investigating Officer and to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh informs the Court that petitioner has since joined investigation.

That apart the observation made in the notice of motion order dated 06.03.2018 have gone unrebutted.

In view of the above, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted.

Order dated 06.03.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of.
