Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing of impugned order dated 04.10.2017 (Annexure P-4) of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, declaring the petitioners as proclaimed persons in case FIR No. 159 dated 10.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Daba Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondent No. 2 is taken on record. Office to tag the same at the appropriate place.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 2 submits that he has no objection in granting bail to the petitioners, in case, they appear before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the petitioners, namely; Paramjit Singh and Davinder Singh, are directed to appear before the trial Court latest by

15.09.2018, along with an application for grant of regular bail which shall be entertained by the trial Court and they shall be admitted to regular bail, subject to their furnishing appropriate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction.

The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
