Counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a better application giving all details with regard to the identity of the applicant as well as the claimant apart from the power of attorney/authority as available on record, which was submitted along with the application dated 06.12.2016 (Annexure P-11). He states that the petitioner would move a detailed application mentioning therein the complete factual position in support of the assertions along with proper identification of the power of attorney as well as the applicant.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed application before the trial Court for collecting the original bank guarantee No.34321LG000315 dated 18.08.2015 amounting to

₹ 10 lacs, which was submitted by Parminder Kaur in case FIR No.183 dated 09.08.2013, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

In case all the apprehensions of the Court as expressed in the impugned order and the reasons, on which the said application was earlier not accepted, are satisfied, the application, if moved, by the petitioner before the Court concerned satisfying the requirement of the statute, the same be considered and decided at an early date preferably within a period of three weeks from the date of submission of such application.
