Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.602, dated 15.10.2017, under Sections 379-A and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegation in the FIR, four boys sat in the car of the complainant at about 3.00 am and thereafter, they snatched the key of the car and slept the complainant and snatched his purse containing about Rs.1500/- and certain documents. He further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and other co-accused, namely, Aman @ Mohit has been granted concession of regular bail by the trial Court vide order dated 22.02.2018. It is further submitted that challan has already been presented on 05.02.2018 and the petitioner is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ramesh, has not disputed the factual position and has submitted that recovery of car was effected from the petitioner. However, it is stated that he is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the investigation in this case is complete and prosecution evidence is yet to start and also in view of the fact that the petitioner is not involved in any other case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
